

ACCOMMODATION FEES 2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR

1. ACCOMMODATION

1.1 Accommodation: single room (with en-suite bathroom, telephone, wifi, piped music) with weekly cleaning; bed linen and towels; free use of washing machines; common rooms; study areas; group work rooms and sports facilities at the University of Deusto and Deusto Hall of Residence, including the gym and the multifunctional training room; own car park.

1.2 **Catering:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner. All week days.

2. FORM OF PAYMENT

2.1 The total amount will be divided into nine instalments of **967.00 euros + VAT (10%)**, to be paid in **nine monthly instalments** from September to May inclusive. Payment will be charged to the bank account indicated by you on the first days of the month.

2.2 A monthly instalment of **817.00 euros + VAT (10%)** will be applied to **students starting the third year** at the Hall of Residence and the third year of their degree course, and those starting the fourth year at the Hall. Such a discount requires these members' real commitment and involvement in the smooth running of the Hall.

2.3 Students who are behind on their payment in more than two instalments will automatically lose their status of members and, hence, their place at the Hall.

3. DEPOSIT

3.1 A **deposit of 850 €** must be paid on acceptance of the place, which will be refunded at the end of the academic year. This deposit must be made by bank transfer to the **BBVA** bank account **No: ES 38 0182-1290-35-0201507432**, payable to Colegio Mayor Deusto, indicating the student's name and **sending a payment receipt to the Hall** before the date indicated in the letter of admission or renewal.

3.2 Failure to make this deposit payment will result in the place offered being withdrawn. **This deposit will not be refunded if the accepted place is declined. In no case shall it be understood as a reason for reimbursement that the student decides to study in another city or region.**

3.3 Repairs to damage caused to furniture, installations, etc., due to negligence on the part of the student, shall be paid for by the student; in the event that the person responsible is not identified, this shall be apportioned among the students. The cost of any such repairs shall be deducted from the security deposit.

4. HALL OPENING AND CLOSING DATES

4.1 First-year students may arrive at the Deusto Hall of Residence on Sunday 4 September 2022. Second-year students and above may arrive on Sunday 11 September. The academic year will end on 13 June 2023.

Students staying outside these two dates will be charged at a rate of 33 euros + VAT (10%) per day.

Any cancellations made during the academic year will not entitle students to a refund of the remaining days of the month in which the cancellation occurs. Temporary or definitive expulsions for disciplinary reasons will not entail a reduction in the payment of the current month's fee. There are no bonuses for holidays, early course end or any other reason.

4.2. In the event that a new state of alarm is decreed, the Hall will remain open unless the health authorities determine otherwise. If this should happen, those who wish to leave the Hall of Residence temporarily will be charged 7 euros per day from their deposit until their return, as a security deposit.

4.3. The Hall will close on 23 December at 10:00 until 8 January at 16:00; at Easter holidays from Holy Wednesday, 5 April at 18:00 to 16 April at 16:00.

5. ACCOMMODATION GRANTS

Hall residents can access the Accommodation grants awarded by the regional governments and the Ministry of Education. Applications must be submitted to the relevant university.
