ACCOMMODATION FEES 2026-2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

1. ACCOMMODATION

1.1 Accommodation: single room (with en-suite bathroom, telephone, wifi) with weekly cleaning; bed linen and towels; free use of washing machines; common rooms; study areas; group work rooms and sports facilities at the University of Deusto and Deusto Hall of Residence, including the gym and the multifunctional training room; own car park.

1.2 **Catering:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner. All week days.

2. HALL OPENING AND CLOSING DATES

2.1 1st year students can arrive at the Hall on Sunday, 30 August 2026. Second-year students and subsequent year students can arrive on Sunday, 6 September. The academic year will end on 11 June 2027.

2.2. The Deusto Hall of Residence will close on 23 December at 10:00 until 6 January at 16:00; at Easter holidays from Holy Wednesday on 24 March at 10:00 to 4 April at 16:00.

3. FORM OF PAYMENT

3.1 The total amount will be divided into nine instalments of **1142 euros + VAT (10%)**, to be paid in **nine monthly instalments** from September to May inclusive. Payment will be charged to the bank account indicated by you on the first days of the month.

3.2 A monthly instalment of **1062.06 euros + VAT (10%)** will be applied to **students starting the third year** at the Hall of Residence and the third year of their degree course, and those starting the fourth year at the Hall. Such a discount requires these members' real commitment and involvement in the smooth running of the Hall.

3.3 Students who are behind on their payment in more than two instalments will automatically lose their status of members and, hence, their place at the Hall.

3.4 Students staying outside the regular academic year will be charged at a rate of 38 euros + VAT (10%) per day.

3.5 Any cancellations made during the academic year will not entitle students to a refund of the remaining days of the month in which the cancellation occurs. Temporary or definitive expulsions for disciplinary reasons will not entail

a reduction in the payment of the current month's fee. There are no bonuses for holidays, early course end or any other reason.

4. DEPOSIT

4.1 A **deposit of 850 €** must be paid on acceptance of the place, which will be refunded at the end of the academic year. This deposit must be made by bank transfer to the **BBVA** bank account **No: ES 38 0182-1290-35-0201507432**, payable to Deusto University, indicating the student's name and **sending a payment receipt to the Hall** before the date indicated in the letter of admission or renewal.

4.2 Failure to make this deposit payment will result in the place offered being withdrawn. **This deposit will not be refunded if the accepted place is declined. In no case shall it be understood as a reason for reimbursement that the student decides to study in another city or region.**

4.3 Repairs to damage caused to furniture, installations, etc., due to negligence on the part of the student, shall be paid for by the student; in the event that the person responsible is not identified, this shall be apportioned among the students involved. The cost of any such repairs shall be deducted from the security deposit.

5. ACCOMMODATION GRANTS

Hall residents may apply for the University of Deusto's Arrupe Accommodation Grants, which can be combined with Residence grants awarded by regional governments and the Ministry of Education. Applications must be submitted to the relevant university.
