

EXPERT DIPLOMA IN SEXUAL VIOLENCE INTERVENTION

Admission Criteria

The training is aimed at:

- *Graduates or diploma holders in Social Work and Social Education; holders of a degree or bachelor's degree in Psychology, Sociology, Pedagogy, Psychopedagogy, Law, Medicine and Nursing; or other related disciplines in the field of social intervention or the Social Sciences, who wish to specialise in order to work professionally in the field of sexual violence, in both public and private bodies, associations and non-governmental organisations.*

Requirements:

As regulated by Royal Decree 822/2021, which establishes the organisation of official university education, applicants must hold an official Spanish university degree, or another degree issued by a higher education institution belonging to another State within the European Higher Education Area that qualifies the holder for access to postgraduate studies in that system.

Graduates holding qualifications from education systems outside the European Higher Education Area may also be admitted without the need for official recognition of their degrees, subject to prior verification by the General Secretariat of the University of Deusto that such qualifications certify a level of training equivalent to the corresponding Spanish university degrees and that they qualify the holder, in the country of issue, for access to postgraduate studies. In accordance with current legislation, access via this route does not, under any circumstances, imply the official recognition of the prior qualification held by the applicant, nor its recognition for any purpose other than undertaking these postgraduate studies.

In accordance with the aforementioned Royal Decree, the University of Deusto guarantees non-discrimination on the grounds of age, sex, race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, origin or any other condition, in access to these studies for any person qualified to do so.

Provided that the admission requirements are met, a candidate may also access and enrol in one or more modules without completing the entire Expert Programme. In this case, the diploma corresponding to the qualification is not issued; instead, an academic certificate is awarded for the modules successfully completed.
