The proposal must follow the following outline:

- Title
- Description
- Hypothesis, research questions and objectives
- Conceptual framework
- Methodology
- Bibliography
- Means and material resources available
- Time planning / Chronogram

On **27 April** the report signed by the principal researcher of the team will be sent to those whose application has been accepted and which must be included in the [online application](#) form available on the University of Deusto website.
